- Chaperones are expected to have emotional maturity, strong problem solving, diplomacy, and leadership skills. During chaperoning events, Chaperones are to be a model in speech, attitude, dress, and refrain from the use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco.
- Chaperones are responsible for the behavior of their students. A Chaperone must remain with students at all times. At no time is a student to be left unsupervised.
- Do not allow students to engage in rowdiness, disrespect, inappropriate voices, or dangerous activities. If you experience difficulties, please refer student to a staff member.

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To facilitate communications, Chaperones are asked to bring a cellular telephone and give the phone number to the staff member in charge. Do you have a cell phone available to you, and is there any problem with sharing your telephone number? _____

Chaperones should not bring others, such as siblings or friends, to the event. Likewise, Chaperones should not arrange to meet anyone at the event. The primary attention must be given to the students. The first duty of the Chaperones is to the students. These students need the undivided attention of the Chaperones. Chaperones must commit to putting aside their personal wishes for the benefit of the experience of the students. The Chaperones must be willing to help the student in all times of need or distress, day, or night. We are grateful that our Chaperone's understand our school policies. Chaperones must travel to and from the event with the busses.

Please note: ALL band fees must be paid in full before you child can go on this trip. You will not be eligible to chaperone this event if your child does not attend.
