

Color Guard Performance Checklist

These items should come with you for a game and/or performance:

Practice flags (always)

Costume Pieces-

- Tan guard shoes
- Black unitard for football games
- Black and silver tunic costume top for football games
- Black compression shirt when directed
- Socks that do not show
- Tan unitard for white costume performances/competitions

Hair Supplies-

- Clear/thin hair ties
- Brush
- Fine tooth comb
- H a i r s p r a y
- Smoothing cream (if needed)
- Bobby pins
- Straightener or Curling method – whichever is easier for your hair

Makeup Products-

- Primer (optional but helpful and recommended)
- Foundation in your skin color or *slightly* lighter
- Powder (optional but recommended when sweaty)
- Pink-like-your-lip lipstick or lip stain plus a lip liner (no gloss!) Looking more toward raspberry than light bubblegum pink...
- Eyebrow pencil or powder
- Black eyeliner
- Black mascara
- Blush in pink tone
- Bronzer
- Highlighter in light/white tone
- Light shimmery natural tone eyeshadow (beige, tan, nude, gold, etc.)
- Darker natural tone eyeshadow (deep brown)

Additional Items-

- A hand towel/washcloth
- DEODORANT
- Baby wipes
- Makeup remover wipes
- Extra shoes
- Guard jacket
- Water bottle
- Small container to hold jewelry you take off
- Appropriate band T-shirt

Remember: You also should have no straps or colored undergarments visible when in either costume. Your black unitard should be hemmed to hang one inch off the ground when standing straight.
